Cold Weather Tips from ASPCA

Brrrr—it's cold outside! The tips below will help you protect your animal companion when the mercury dips.



Keep your cat inside. Outdoors, cats can freeze, get lost or stolen, or end up injured and killed. They may also get infectious diseases, like rabies, from other animals.

Cats will sleep under the hoods of cars to keep warm. When the motor is started, a cat can get seriously hurt by a fan belt. If there are outdoor cats in your area, bang loudly on the car hood before starting the engine to give the cat a chance to escape.

Dogs can easily become lost during storms, so never let them off leash in snow or ice. Make sure they always wear ID tags.

Carefully clean your dog's legs and stomach when he comes in out of cold weather. He can lick dangerous chemicals like antifreeze off his paws, and snow or ice can tear up paw pads. Morton makes pet-safe ice melt that will help keep your dog safe.

Never shave your dog to the skin in winter; a longer coat will keep them warm. When bathing dogs in the cold weather, be sure he's totally dry before taking him outside. A coat or sweater with a high collar, or turtleneck with coverage from the base of the tail to the belly will keep short-haired breeds snug.

Never leave your pet alone in a car during cold weather. A car can be a refrigerator in the winter, holding in the cold and causing the animal to freeze to death.

Puppies do not tolerate cold as well as adults, so may be hard to housebreak during winter. If they are easily chilled, you may opt to paper-train him inside. Dogs sensitive to the cold due to age, illness or breed type should only go outside to potty.

If your dog spends a lot of time outdoors, increase his food supply--particularly protein--to keep him and his fur in tip-top shape.

Coolant and antifreeze are lethal poisons for pets. Be sure to thoroughly clean up any spills from your vehicle, and consider using products that contain propylene glycol rather than ethylene glycol.

Make sure your pet has a warm place to sleep, off the floor and away from all drafts. A cozy bed with a warm blanket or pillow is perfect.
